- Place burnable garbage and landfill waste in a designated Niimi City garbage bag with your name written on.
- Put recyclables in a 45 litter or smaller transparent bag with your name written on.

(Semi-transparent bags and shopping bags are not acceptable.)

• Tie the top of the bag and place at the designated location for garbage collection by 8:00 am on the collection day.
