

# Garbage becomes resources if separated – Thank you for your cooperation in separating garbage.

- Place burnable garbage and landfill waste in a **designated Niimi City garbage bag** with **your name** written on.
- Put recyclables in a 45 liter or smaller **transparent bag** with **your name** written on.  
(Semi-transparent bags and shopping bags are not acceptable.)
- Tie the top of the bag and place at the designated location for garbage collection by **8:00 am** on the collection day.

Items containing yarn, leather, or cotton, futons and blankets are burnable garbage. ○ Rugs and carpets are bulky garbage, and curtains and sheets are burnable garbage.			
						<b>•Furniture, home appliances, and other large items</b> [Flow of Collection] ①Apply (phone/counter) → ②The waste disposal center will call about the collection day. → ③Place the large items at the designated location on the collection day. 	<b>•Items specified by the Home Appliance Recycling Act</b> <b>•Air conditioners</b> <b>•Televisions</b> <b>•Refrigerators, Freezers</b> <b>•Washers</b> <b>•Dryers</b> <b>•Items that are not accepted for collection</b> ①Explosives, gas cylinders, and other items that may explode ②Poisons, agricultural chemicals, toxins, and other chemicals and their containers ③Tires, automobile components, fire extinguishers, batteries, solar panels, solar water heaters, boilers, and copy machines ④Concrete blocks, bricks, concrete debris, roof tiles, large sections of waste wood ⑤Agricultural equipment, agricultural materials (Mulch, corrugated sheets for paddy-field ridges, vinyl for greenhouses, seedling boxes, etc.) ⑥Industrial waste (Construction materials, container pallets, etc.) ⑦Large amount paints, other coloring materials ⑧Waste oil such as automobile oil and kerosene ⑨Other items that are difficult to dispose of at city facilities										
<b>•How to dispose of air conditioners, televisions, refrigerators, washers and dryers</b> ○ For replacement • Ask the place of purchase when buying a new product to arrange for disposal. ○ For disposal only • If you remember the place of purchase, ask the store to arrange for disposal. • If you do not remember the place of purchase, or if the store is closed, consult a waste disposal agent.
